All participating students in our programs, as well as their parents or guardians must read, understand and accept SAIIE terms and conditions.

Our programs are created for the student to immerse themselves into the Spanish Culture by living with a Spanish Family. They are not on holidays abroad. The purpose of this program is to understand and adapt voluntarily, to appreciate and value the similarities and differences between their home culture with the Spanish Culture. Students become therefore ambassadors of their countries and must represent the United States positively.

By signing this document, the student, the parents or legal guardian(s) understand that:

Conditions of participation

- Attending class is mandatory, the student must complete all assigned homework and study after class. The student should uphold an adequate level of academic performance and respect the school rules. In the event that the student is expelled from school due to misbehaviour or the swimming club, they must return home immediately.
- The student will respect and follow all Spanish laws and rules.
- The student is responsible to cover all costs for any break or damaged made at the school, the swimming club, host family or any other location while participating in the program.
- The student's personal property is not the responsibility of SAIIE or the host family. Any lost or stolen personal property of the student, including money, which is not covered by any insurance policy, is responsibility of the student.
- To travel on the dates approved by SAIIE.
- Students may not enter into any kind of business contractual agreement.

Host family programs participants must also abide by the following rules:

- To live as a participating member of the host family and to accept normal family responsibilities, and to adapt to and live within the rules and customs of the host family, showing respect for the host parents.

- Money: Under no circumstances may the participant borrow money from their host family.
- Curfew – **For all students under 18 years old.** From Sunday – Thursday must be at home by 11:00pm. Friday and Saturday must be at home by 12:00 midnight.

Changing Host Family

In the extraordinary situation where the student is not treated correctly and respectfully by their host family, the student must immediately notify the SAIIE Director and we will find a replacement family within a period of 1 week.

If there is a health or safety issue, the student will be moved without delay within the same day.

Insurance

SAIIE does not provide health and medical evacuation insurance. It is the student's responsibility to acquire this for the student to participate in the program.

Fees

The **\$3,425** fees for our programs in Spain covers all mandated program expenses from the time of the student's arrival to destination until the termination of the program.

Summer 2025 Program cost covers:

- SAIIE support services before, during and after trip.
- Airport reception in Sevilla and transportation to Spanish home on arrival date.
- On-site orientation.
- SAIIE on-site staff support 24/7.
- WhatsApp group created with all the students and program directors available 24/7
- Bilingual staff (English/Spanish) staff.
- Accommodation with all meals (3 meals per day / breakfast, lunch, and dinner), and one load of laundry (colour and whites) throughout the duration of the program.
- 2-week Intensive Spanish language course at the SAIIE Center. Mo-Fri (2 hrs per day)

- Swimming License with Spanish swimming team to be able to participate in swimming event.
- 3-day swim meet (Fri- Su). If swim meet is held outside Seville, accommodation and meals, as well as, transportation where event as held are included.
- Swimming practice with Spanish team prior to competition.
- Gym membership at swimming facilities.
- 15-day pass membership at Swimming club to use all facilities (includes swimming pools, sports facilities, restaurants, green area, showers, etc.)
- Welcome meal.
- Farewell meal.
- All social/cultural activities listed below:
 - Visit Barrio de Santa Cruz (Old Jewish Quarter)
 - Walk around city
 - Ceramic workshop
 - Spanish cooking workshop
 - Flamenco show
 - Go for churros con chocolate
 - Tapas night out (dinner)
 - Visit Metropol Parasol (Las Setas)
 - Visit Plaza España
 - Escape Room
- Day trip to the beach.
- SAIIE Certification at the end of the Spanish language course certifying the amount of hours and course taken.

Early returns

When a student withdraws voluntarily from the program or is expelled from the program at any time following their departure from the home country, there will be no refunds. SAIIE shall not be responsible for travel arrangements or in any other manner whatsoever, if the student leaves the program voluntarily. SAIIE reserves the right to dismiss and to send home any student whose mental or physical health requires action

Such conduct includes, but is not restricted to, illegal drug use or possession, driving, drinking of alcoholic beverages, smoking, violation of law, eating disorders, unsatisfactory school performance, or other evidence that the student is not capable of, or is unwilling to, participate fully in a cross-cultural environment. The organization also reserves the right to dismiss any participant who is found to have misrepresented him/herself or provided false information in the program application.

If you must cancel your program due to a personal emergency, please notify SAIIE in writing as soon as possible prior to your departure from the program and we will review your claim. SAIIE reserves the right to make final decision on any refunds.

Personal risk

The participant acknowledges and accepts the responsibilities and risks that international study programs include. The participant fully and solely accepts these risks as an inherent part of their planned travel.

The participant assumes all liability and responsibility for any eventuality that may occur, including personal injury, emotional distress, death, and/or loss or damage to personal property. Furthermore, the participant agrees to hold harmless SAIIE, its partners, its management, and its employees. The participant also agrees NOT to make any type of claim, financial or otherwise, against any of the parties.

SAIIE reserves the right to remove any person from any program or activity if that person's actions or behaviour impede the operation of the program or infringe on the rights, welfare, and enjoyment of other participants. Anyone removed from a program will NOT be entitled to a refund or discount.

Liability release agreement

We do hereby release SAIIE, its offices, host families and agents, from all claims and causes of action for loss of property, personal injury or illness, accident, delay or expense sustained by any participant arising out of any travel or activity conducted by or under the control of SAIIE. We also release SAIIE and its agents and agree to indemnify them regarding any financial obligations or liabilities that the applicant may personally incur or any damage or injury to the person or property of the others that the applicant may cause while participating in this program. In the event that SAIIE or its agents advance or loan any monies to the applicant or incur special expenses on his/her or behalf, we agree to make immediate repayment.
