A. COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVE

A1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Classes will be fundamentally practical using slides and commenting on those slides as part of class discussion.

To make the most of this class, students must always prepare the theory documents that the teacher will give them. These documents comprise introductions to different artistic movements, biographies of the main painters and some complementary reading.

A2. COURSE OBJECTIVE

The main objective of this course is knowledge of the most important styles and figures of Spanish painting in the period spanning between the end of the 15th Century and the 20th Century.

We offer students the necessary basis in order to understand the different painters and their works and we will emphasize the socio-economical and mental characteristics of the society in which each painter developed their work.

The central idea is that the student not only recognizes the work of each painter but also the reasons behind this work.

C. EXAMS AND CLASS ATTENDANCE

C2. CLASS ATTENDACE
